On behalf of the Association of Insurance Supervisors of Latin America (ASSAL), the Financial Stability Institute (FSI) and the International Association of Insurance Supervisors (IAIS), it is our pleasure to invite you and your staff to participate in the **Regional Seminar for Insurance Supervisors in Latin America on Corporate Governance and Enterprise Risk Management**.
